The push is an ode to Cunard's return to Australian shores and the country itself.

The TVC was shot on the bow of *Queen Elizabeth* as she sailed into Sydney Harbour for the first time since the pandemic.

The commercial features Goodrem performing iconic bush ballad *Waltzing Matilda*, accompanied by a string quartet and flanked by Cunard officers & bellboys in their uniforms.

The campaign launches to coincide with the start of the Australian Open today, and will see a 30-second TVC running across various channels, VOD; and a full 100-second version on social media and YouTube for three months.

"I've performed in many locations around the world but performing on the bow of *Queen Elizabeth* as she sailed through Sydney Harbour was one of my highlights," Goodrem said. "As we neared the Opera House and Harbour Bridge, performing *Waltzing Matilda* was truly a magical moment."

Cunard Vice President Commercial Matt Gleaves said "we wanted to show our Australian audience how special Australia is for Cunard, particularly after our long twoand-a-half-year absence.

"It would be remiss of us to not take advantage of one of the world's most breath-taking harbours to be centre stage of our new campaign.

"Adding superstar Delta Goodrem's performance into the mix makes this commercial one of the most iconic our brand has ever produced."

Goodrem is the latest celebrity to link herself with Cunard, as the cruise line celebrates a century of welcoming stars on board, such as Cary Grant and Elizabeth Taylor, in its new 'Sea Views' photography exihibition (*CW* 11 Jan).

## Resorts World to charter Explorer

**RESORTS** World Cruises (RWC) will charter a second ship *Explorer Dream* to operate its short cruises to nowhere from Hong Kong, starting in Mar.

*Explorer* was most recently operated by the now-defunct Dream Cruises (*CW* 01 Mar 2022), and will now be charted by RWC from an unknown buyer, and renamed *Resorts World One*.

She will sail two- and threenight cruises from Hong Kong on a Fri, Sun, and Wed rotation from 10 Mar.

One will also replace RWC's first ship Genting Dream, another former Dream ship, on her twoand three-night sailngs from 17 Feb to 01 Mar, as she dry docks for routine maintenance.

RWC has been sailing from Singapore and Port Klang since last Jun and Jul respectively with *Genting*, which it charters from a consortium of banks which



acquired the ship in 2020.

One is now expected to become the first cruise ship to homeport in Hong Kong since 05 Jan 2022 when local officials imposed widespread measures to stem the spread of COVID-19.

Before that, cruises to nowhere carrying only locals had been operating for half a year, starting in Jul 2021 with Dream and Royal Caribbean International (*CW* 03 Aug 2021).

It has not been all smooth sailing since RWC's start however, with a number of passengers unable to board *Genting* late last year after the cruise line overbooked one of its cruises (*CW* 14 Sep 2022).



A ROYAL Caribbean International ship has rescued more than a dozen people from a tiny boat in the Bahamas on the weekend.

*Liberty of the Seas* rescued 17 people thought to be Cuban migrants on their way to the Bahamas.

The ship had actually skipped a planned trip to CocoCay, its private island in the Bahamas, due to heavy winds, which put *Liberty* on a lucky path to intercepting the migrants.

The boat had been adrift for weeks, *Liberty's* Captain said.

The rescue took about 45 minutes, and is the latest in a series of cruise-migrant encounters in the Atlantic.

## Secret Atlas' secret revealed



SMALL ship expedition company Secret Atlas is welcoming a new member to its fleet the new Vikingfjord (render pictured).

The new ice-strengthened ship can host 12 guests in nine en suite cabins, and is powered by a modern, fuel-efficient engine, which is able to achieve a 95% reduction in nitric oxide emissions.

Sailing in May, guests can join Vikingfjord on one of Secret Atlas' micro-cruises, photo tours, or a private expedition in Svalbard.

Vikingfjord features an openplan saloon with rear-facing windows, a hot tub, and a sauna.

There is also a large guest area with lounge, dining, and seating located at the stern.

The space is equipped with a television for presentations, a minibar, and hot drink service.

She is equipped with two Zodiac landing crafts for shore landings, and is fully staffed with expedition leaders.

Guests can enjoy an observation lounge area, and prepare for their expeditions in a large mudroom and storage space for skis and equipment.

#### Coral's Tas summer

A RECORD summer season is on the horizon for Coral Expeditions in Tasmania, including circumnavigations, coastal treks, golf, and cycling.

The new voyages are creating new demand for expeditions, with a record 12 voyages between Jan and Mar.

Coral will carry more than 800 guests during the summer, which launched with Coral Adventurer making a series of stops in Tasmania, including Stanley, Hobart, Bruny Island, Maria Island, and Flinders Island, on her iconic 60-day Circumnavigation of Australia vovage.

Meanwhile, Coral Discoverer is currently on expedition with 70 guests on the season's first 16-night Tasmania Circumnavigation.

Coral is also working with international partners for the first time for new themed charter voyages, which are the perfect fit for Tasmania's tourism strategy of experiential high-end visitors.

This includes a special charter for golfers visiting courses on King Island, Barnbougle, and Hobart, over the eight-day Feb expedition.
