Azamara plots 2021/22 Australasia

AZAMARA Cruises looks set to deploy its *Azamara Journey* (pictured) in local waters over the 2021/22 summer season, with the cruise line releasing itinerary details this week, including a full circumnavigation of New Zealand.

Azamara Journey will arrive in local waters from Asia late next year, cruising from Bali on a 12-night voyage to Perth which will disembark on 19 Dec 2021.

She will then undertake a 16night Australia Intensive voyage around the country's south to Sydney over the festive season, via Albany, Kangaroo Island, Portland, Melbourne and Eden.

On 04 Jan 2022 the ship then continues on to New Zealand on a 16-night Trans-Tasman cruise, before undertaking a 16-night New Zealand Intensive voyage around the country, roundtrip from Auckland, visiting the Bay of Islands, Norfolk Island,



New Plymouth, Milford Sound, Dunedin, Akaroa, Wellington, Nelson, Picton, Napier and Tauranga.

The itinerary is expected to be popular with locals, and has been hailed by House of Travel's Jeff Leckey.

"This is just what regional New Zealand needs to help us with a

provincial tourism recovery," he said.

The 2021/22 Azamara program also includes a 16-night New Zealand and Australia golffocused voyage ex Auckland on 05 Feb 2022, followed by a 17-night cruise up the Australian east coast from Sydney to Singapore departing on 22 Feb.

The trials were completed during 08 and 20 Aug, carrying a reduced crew of approximately 320 on the journey between Fincantieri's shipyards in Ancona and Trieste.

Silver Moon will become the second ship to join Silversea's fleet this year, following the delivery of Silver Origin on 03 Jun (**CW** 09 Jun).

The future of cruising

AS THE industry works through how we re-start cruising in Australia, the future may well look very different and we applaud the creativity behind these plans.

Naturally, any new itineraries will be filtered through the lens of safety – what will work best for passengers and crew, but also importantly the local communities the ships will visit.

The first option might be intrastate cruising where ships are not crossing any borders, and provide in- depth itineraries.

Coral Expeditions is a perfect example.

With the company's homeport in Cairns, they have been forced to cancel their usual Western Australia and Tasmania sailings and instead are now focusing on Great Barrier Reef journeys from mid-Oct.

Another opportunity being explored by cruise lines is to include multi-day shore excursions which celebrate the best of sea and shore.

While land-based tours would usually be considered as pre- or post cruise add-ons, we may now see these being seamlessly integrated into one itinerary.

APT has already announced a Jul 2021 sailing which features a nine-night cruise and four nights on land, with two at Bungle Bungle Wilderness Lodge and an exciting foodie experience with chef, Luke Nguyen.

We look forward to working with the cruise lines to support these interesting new endeavours.
