Oceania hops onto the Kangaroo Route

OCEANIA Cruises has unveiled 'The Kangaroo Route', a sailing from Sydney to London calling on 80 ports aboard Vista.

The 129-day voyage, named for the air route between Australia and the UK via the Orient, will visit more than 30 countries across four continents.

Vista, which carries 1,200 pax, will depart 26 Feb 2027, and make overnight calls in Cairns, Shanghai, Tokyo, Singapore, Mumbai, Luxor, and Bordeaux.

The four-and-a-half month adventure will begin journeying along the coastline of Australia, before spending more than two months exploring the cultural wonders of Asia, such as Indonesia, Japan, and India.

Vista will then visit the desert metropolises of Dubai, Abu Dhabi, and Doha, followed by Egypt and the Mediterranean. The ship will also visit Greece,

Italy, Croatia, Sicily, the Italian and French rivieras, the Costa del Sol, and France's wine country.



MSC goes big for winter

SEVEN ships cruising from three American home ports, including four based in Miami, will make up MSC Cruises' deployment in the United States for the 2026/27 winter season.

Headlining MSC's Miami program will be the cruise line's newest ship, MSC World America, (pictured) which will run alternating seven-night tours of the Caribbean.

Miami will also feature MSC Meraviglia sailing rotating six- and eight-night Caribbean cruises to a variety of destinations, including San Juan, St Maarten, the Virgin Islands, and St Kitts & Nevis.

Meraviglia is being deployed to Miami after MSC cancelled five months of existing cruises from the ship's former home port in New York City.

For travellers with less time, MSC Seaside will offer a collection of three- and four-night getaways to Nassau and Ocean Cay MSC Marine Reserve, the line's private Caribbean island.

Conversely, longer sailings on MSC Poesia will complete the cruise line's program from Miami.

The ship will transit through the Panama Canal to Miami from Seattle, following the completion of her maiden season in Alaska.

Poesia will offer sailings ranging from 10-21 nights venturing deeper into the Caribbean, reaching as far south as Panama and Costa Rica.

Elsewhere in Florida, the line



will base MSC Grandiosa and MSC Seashore in Port Canaveral, where they will offer sailings ranging from three to 14 nights to the Caribbean.

Completing the deployment will be MSC Seascape, which will be based in Galveston, offering seven-night loops of the western Caribbean, visiting Costa Maya, Roatan, and Cozumel.

The line's North America President Lynn Torrent said more people are choosing to sail with MSC in the United States, whether they are first-timers or experienced cruisers.

"Our commitment to the US market and Miami is creating new options for our guests and generating exciting opportunities for our valued travel advisor partners," she said.

"Deploying some of our newest and largest ships to an even wider variety of destinations gives vacationers more ways to enjoy our unique mix of European style and American comfort on everything from a quick weekend getaway to a once-in-a-lifetime

CUNARD Line has unveiled English actor Hugh Bonneville as its newest 'Insight Speaker' for its upcoming maiden Caribbean season (CW 22 Jul).

The Paddington and Downton Abbey star will join Queen Elizabeth from 27 Nov to 03 Dec, offering passengers an exclusive glimpse behind the curtain of his distinguished career in film, TV, and theatre.

Bonneville will be on board Queen Elizabeth's 12-night round trip Eastern Caribbean voyage departing from Miami.

The cruise will call in Antigua, St. Lucia, Barbados, St. Maarten, and Tortola.

"I look forward to sharing a few stories, hopefully a laugh or two, and exploring the Caribbean with my fellow guests," Bonneville said.

President Katie McAlister added: "We're delighted to welcome Hugh on board Queen Elizabeth this year.

Syd Dance Company on HLC



HAPAG-LLOYD Cruises' (HLC) *Europa 2* will be home to the world premiere at sea of the Sydney Dance Company in 2026.

Star choreographer Rafael Bonachela will lead two exclusive works aboard *Europa 2*, including a new production, featuring South American and Spanish musical influences.

The piece will debut on *Europa* 2's spring cruise through the Canary Islands, sailing from 11-21 Apr from Tenerife to La Gomera.

Bonachela and Sydney Dance Company will be welcomed aboard under HLCs 'Dance Visions 2026' program, which invites world-renowned choreographers to present specially commissioned works in its ships' intimate theatres.

Another highlight of the program will be *Poetic*Body & Ritual from Italian choreographer Diego Tortelli and Compagnia Aterballetto.

The renowned company will perform for the first time aboard *Europa* 2, presenting a piece reflecting on human connection in a digital age.

Compagnia Aterballetto will be on board for a voyage from 16-25 Aug travelling between Rome and Dubronvik, and the 10-18 Oct Palma to Lisbon cruise.

NCL's new Vibes

NORWEGIAN Cruise Line (NCL) is adding its adults-only area to two more ships.

Vibe Beach Club will be added to *Norwegian Jewel* and *Norwegian Pearl*, which are both scheduled for a dry dock this spring.

The child-free sun deck features a bar and hot tub, with paid admission required for entry.

Vibe will also offer a sun lounge space for more than 50 people, water misters, fruit skewers, chilled towels, and seven cabanas that are bookable for an additional fee.

The space will replace the sun deck on deck 14 on both of the ships.

Hamburg powers up

THE Port of Hamburg expects its shore power connection will be utilised by all able cruise ships calling the destination by 2027.

All of Hamburg's cruise terminals will be equipped with shore power by next year, four years ahead of the European Union-wide obligation from 2030.

Hamburg already has agreements with a number of lines to utilise shore power.
