Palau to redevelop port with cruise focus

THE island country of Palau is redeveloping its main port in an effort to attract more cruise calls, the destination's tourism head has revealed.

The port on Malakal Island, the site of much of urban Palau's tourism activity, is set to begin renovations next year.

Palau Visitors Authority Managing Director Kadoi Ruluked told *CW* the renovations will address the small- to mediumsized cruise sector, as well as private yachts, attending to the destination's long-term infrastructure problem.

Malakal Island is linked to Koror, Palau's largest city, by a causeway, which would allow passengers easy access to the destination's range of tourism offerings, including diving and snorkelling, boat tours, and hiking. "There's long-term planning for



[the cruise sector]; it's going to be a really big port that's going to address the commercial and private yachts, and the cruise lines," Ruluked said.

"We've been advertising Palau as another cruise destination, it's just that...we do not have really good infrastructure for the cruise ships," he added.

Palau receives very few calls per year, mostly from Hapag-Lloyd Cruises, with ships anchoring off the island of Ngerdis.

Hanseatic Inspiration and Hanseatic Spirit are the only two cruise ships scheduled to call Palau this year. MS

New APT/SCL trip

APT has unveiled a brandnew tour alongside its partner Seabourn Cruise Line (SCL) aboard Seabourn Venture.

The new exclusive 13-day Britain & Ireland Explorer will depart next year, offering a journey to natural wonders, castles, and World Heritagelisted sites.

Guests will explore Edinburgh, Orkney, the Isle of Man, and Dublin, with unique experiences including meeting the residents of Fair Isle, Britain's most remote inhabited island, and morning tea in the community hall.

Guests will also explore Fingal's Cave, a sea cave on the uninhabited island of Staffa, offering an up-close view of its hexagonal basalt columns, which were formed by volcanic activity more than 60 million years ago.

There will also be four ships embarking from Florida for the season, with the new Disney Destiny (CW 20 Jan) to cruise from Fort Lauderdale, and three ships (Disney Fantasy, Disney Wish, and Disney Treasure) to sail from Port Canaveral. MS
