### HX reveals commercial strategy lead for ANZ

**HX EXPEDITIONS** has appointed a commercial strategy leader for the local market, with the promotion of Nathaniel Sherborne (pictured) as SVP and Managing Director, EMEA, ANZ, and Global Sales Enablement (CW breaking news).

Australia now sits within the UK and Europe structure under Sherborne's global remit, while Steve Smotrys - who previously looked after the local market will continue in his role as MD & SVP. Commercial Americas. focusing on driving growth across the North American market.

Sherborne's newly expanded remit will see him drive commercial strategy across EMEA and ANZ, while continuing to steer global sales enablement to support HX's international growth.

Sherborne, who initially joined HX in 2023 as Vice President of Sales and Marketing for the UK



and Nordics, will also look after the line's guest excellence team.

"The broadening of my remit across EMEA and ANZ, alongside continuing to lead global sales enablement and the integration of our GX team, comes at an important time for HX as we move toward our 130th anniversary," he said.

"As we approach this milestone, these developments strengthen our ability to elevate the customer experience, drive performance across key regions, and support the next phase of the brand's global growth."

Sherborne's promotion comes two months' after Cruise Weekly exclusively revealed the upcoming

departure of three executives from the cruise line (CW 24 Sep).

The leadership shuffle saw the exit of Chief Commercial Officer Alex Delamere-White. Vice President People & Culture Belinda Henriksen, and Chief Expedition Officer Alex McNeil.

At the time, HX said it will not replace any of the three roles as part of the restructure, and confirmed there was no impact to the local office. JM

### Oceania offers sneak peek of Sonata

**OCEANIA** Cruises unveiled a sneak peek of its upcoming ship Oceania Sonata (render pictured) this week, on the christening cruise of its latest ship Oceania Allura (CW yesterday).

Sonata will be the first ship in the cruise line's new class, which will be named after the vessel, with CCO Nathan Hickman revealing some of what guests can look forward to.

The new vessel will be the most spacious and amenity-rich to date, with Hickman divulging 30% of all accommodations on board will be suites, up from around 25% on Allura.

Sonata also will debut two brand-new suite categories, one of which will be named the Horizon suite.

This accommodation will sit between the Oceania and Penthouse suite, equalling the equivalent of two standard



staterooms, with 50 of this category on board the new ship.

Sonata's Owner's suites will also be reimagined, with the accommodation class to now feature two bedrooms.

Oceania will be adding two new dining concepts to Sonata without removing any which appear aboard Allura, Hickman said, a possibility thanks to the ship's larger size.

This will include one haute cuisine venue and a far more casual offering, he added.

There will also be more space added to the Aquamar Kitchen and Terrace Cafe venues.

Itinerary highlights include Celebrity' first-ever dedicated Grand Turk itineraries in the Caribbean, which will be operated by Celebrity Xcel.

Guests will be able to enjoy immersive experiences both ashore at destinations like Grand Cayman, St. Thomas, and St. Kitts, and on board through The Bazaar.

Southern Caribbean sailings will be available on Celebrity Ascent (pictured), with more sailings through the Panama Canal, and visits to Antigua, and St. Lucia.

Celebrity Solstice and Celebrity Millennium will sail to almost 50 destinations across seven countries, offering well over 100 port days staying more than 10 hours in destination.



Highlights include overnight stays in Hong Kong on New Year's Eve, and visits to Bali, Thailand, Vietnam, and Malaysia.

Celebrity Equinox will offer 14-night journeys to 17 destinations across seven countries, featuring Patagonian glaciers, Chilean Fjords, Iguazu Falls, Cape Horn, and more.

Additionally, there will be yearround, seven-night sailings on Celebrity Beyond from Miami and Fort Lauderdale, including visits to Aruba, Bonaire, Curacao, and Perfect Day at CocoCay.

Celebrity Reflection will also visit the Royal Caribbean Group private island.

MEANWHILE, Celebrity Cruises' new ship Celebrity Xcel was named yesterday in Fort Lauderdale.

The cruise line gathered its employees, trade partners, international media, and more around Xcel's pool deck for the ceremony, which featured performances from the ship's onboard entertainment team.

Formalities included a pipe and drum corps presentation from the St. Andrews Pipe Band of Miami, as well as an electrified performance of the American national anthem from house guitarist Jeff Arnold. MS



### **Princess Caribbean**

**PRINCESS** Cruises has announced its biggest Caribbean and Panama Canal program yet, visiting 31 ports and sailing from five home ports for the 2027-28 season.

New for the cruise line, Princess will introduce port calls to Celebration Key as part of its expanded Caribbean deployment beginning 01 Nov 2026, with the first call from its newest ship, Star Princess.

From Oct 2027 through Apr 2028, travellers can enjoy 187 departures on nine ships during the Caribbean season, which will offer 43 itineraries ranging in length from four to 15 days and more late-night stays in the ABC islands.

Meanwhile, the Panama Canal season will operate from Sep 2027 through Apr 2028, with 22 departures on five ships across nine itineraries.

### Aroya's president departs

AROYA Cruises President, Jorg Rudolph (pictured), has departed the Saudi Arabian cruise line as it prepares to enter its next phase of growth.

From early 2024, Rudolph has served as Aroya's first president (CW 10 Jan 2024), joining from Costa Cruises in Germany, where he was Managing Director.

With two decades of global cruise experience under his belt at lines including TUI Cruises, AIDA Cruises, Carnival Cruise Line, and Royal Caribbean International, Rudolph's appointment was considered pivotal for launching the first domestic Arabian cruise line.

His responsibilities as president included operations, financials, sales, marketing, guest experience, itinerary planning, revenue management and customer services.

Lars Clasen, Chief Executive



Officer of Cruise Saudi, will act as interim president while maintaining his current position.

"Dr. Rudolph has played a key role in the early success of Aroya Cruises, helping bring the product to life," said Clasen.

"As we move into our next chapter, this transition represents a natural and positive evolution for Aroya Cruises.

"We are focused on accelerating growth, enhancing performance, and continuing to deliver... experiences that reflect the spirit and hospitality of Saudi Arabia," Clasen added. JM

#### Greece milestone

**GREECE'S** Chania has marked a cruise milestone, welcoming its highest-ever number of passengers in one year.

More than 400,000 cruise passengers visited the Crete city in 2025, compared to around 286,000 last year - a nearly 40% increase YoY.

Additionally, Chania has already recorded 204 ship calls in 2025, compared to 144 arrivals in 2024.
